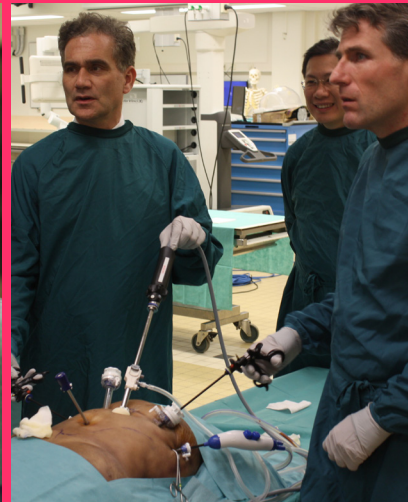
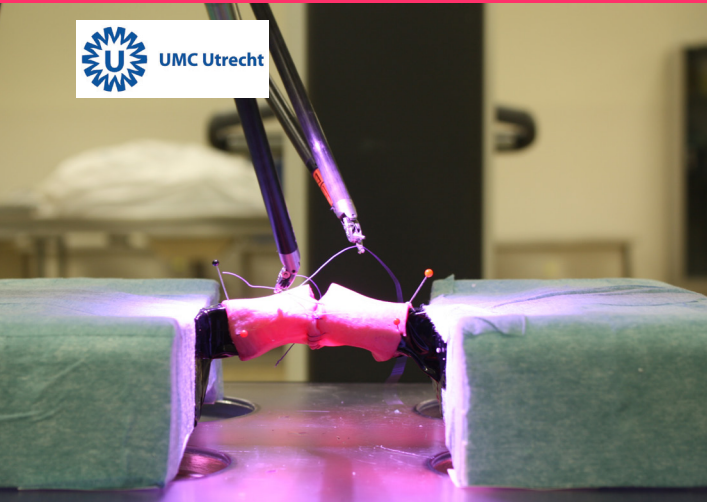


ESSO Hands-on Course on Minimally Invasive Esophagectomy and Gastrectomy
